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Daycare Rules and regulations:

We accept dogs of all ages. Puppies must be over 10 weeks and on a vaccination program. Puppies or shelter dogs must have been in the home for at least two weeks prior to attending daycare.

All dogs over the age of 12 months must be spayed or neutered (unless special permission is given)

All dogs require up to date vaccinations for rabies, DHLPP, and bordetella. Proof of vaccination or titer testing is required.

Dogs that are currently ill or injured are not permitted at daycare. Dogs who have recovered from a communicable illness within the past 30 days must provide veterinary clearance to return to daycare. Owners certify by signing this application that their dog is in good health.

If your dog incurs veterinary bills during their stay at daycare you, the legal owner of the animal, must pay those bills at

time of pickup. Covenant Keeper's K9 Daycare reserves the right to seek veterinary care for your dog at its discretion.

All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy possessive. Owners certify by signing this application that their dog has no history of threatening or harming any person or animal.

We reserve the right to refuse any dog for any reason at any time.

Pick-ups must be completed by 6 PM. Late fees for late pick-ups do apply at a rate of \$15.00 for every 15 minutes past 6 PM. No exceptions.

Daycare passes have no cash value and are non-refundable. No exceptions.

Owner is aware and agrees dog will be put into a crate/kennel on a regular basis and is where he/she will sleep/rest

I recognize the risk of injury to dogs in playgroups/commingling (boarding, training, day care, grooming) even when directly supervised. I authorize my dog to interact, under direct human supervision, with other dogs.

#### Waiver of Liability

I, the undersigned, am satisfied that Covenant Keeper's K9 Daycare is maintained for the health, comfort, and protection of my animal(s). I am the owner/agent of the above named animal(s) and will not hold Covenant Keeper's K9 owner or staff responsible for any accident or injury or loss or death of my animal on or off the premises at 5632 Paradise Rd Delta, Co unless caused by gross negligence by the owner or staff of said company. I further understand that due to the way dogs interact with one another, minor cuts, scratches, and other injuries can occur even though the dogs are carefully supervised. While my animal(s) is/are in the care and custody of Covenant Keeper's K9 LLC, if I am unreachable in the event of an emergency, I hereby authorize Covenant Keeper's K9 LLC, its agents, and/or representatives to seek immediate veterinary care for my animal(s). I understand that all costs in connection with veterinary or medical treatment shall be my responsibility. I certify that my animal(s) is/are in good health and have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog. I agree to pay the cost of training and/or daycare services for my animal(s). I also agree to be financially responsible for undue personal or property damage caused by my animal(s). If any claim is made against Covenant Keeper's K9 LLC. owner or staff by reason of any act of my animal(s), I agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend Covenant Keeper's K9 LLC. against such a claim. I certify that I have read and understand the rules and regulations herein and that I have read and understand this this agreement. I agree to abide by the rules and regulations and accept all terms, conditions, and statements of this agreement and confirm the truthfulness of the contents of the application form completed by me. #### **Bark Collar & Training Collars**

I only use non-aggressive, force free training methods based upon the science of behavior and behavior change. These force free methods are recommended by educated Veterinarians and Veterinary Behaviorists, American Animal Hospital Association, American Veterinary Medical Association, American Veterinary Society of Animal Behavior, and modern dog trainers like myself.

As such, I do not permit the use of choke, prong, when your dog is in my care. I also do not permit the use of dominance-based training, including knee jabs, scruff shakes, side kicks, alpha rolls, spray bottles or any other forceful, painful or aggressive training methods. Shock devices can be considered as a aversive 'training' tool and are not typically recommended for effective behavior change and modification. That being said sometimes the use of a bark collar or training collar may be needed. By signing bellow you agree to the use of either.

Safety and setting up success for you and your pet is of utmost importance. We follow common sense and recommended guidelines.

The more time dedicate to working with your pet, the more successful we will be. I can teach and advise, BUT I CANNOT DO THE TRAINING FOR YOU. Success in training reflects the time and effort you put into the process.
